What does *alibi* mean? Read these definitions and write the meaning of this word: _____.

1. accused's claim of having been elsewhere: a form of defense against an accusation in which the accused person claims to have been somewhere other than at the scene of the crime when the crime was committed

2. somebody used to establish alibi: somebody or something used to prove that somebody else was elsewhere at the time that a crime was committed
