

SENTENCE AUCTION

Steps to take:

Students work in groups of two.

They are given 100 pounds: 2 £20 notes / 10 £5 notes / 10 £1 notes.

A sentence is written on the blackboard or displayed on the computer screen.
The sentence can be **right** or **wrong**.

They have to decide on the sentence: if it is right they can buy it and pay as much money as they can afford. They should avoid buying the wrong ones. They shouldn't spend all the money at first although they think the sentence is right.

The winners will be the ones who bought the higher number of correct sentences.

Teacher takes the money from the students who have bought the sentences and keep it safe.

Suggested vocabulary: *auction / going for "one hundred pounds" / Gone!!*
numbers: *one hundred / one thousand...*

10. IS YOUR PLANE AT ELEVEN ATA NIGHT?

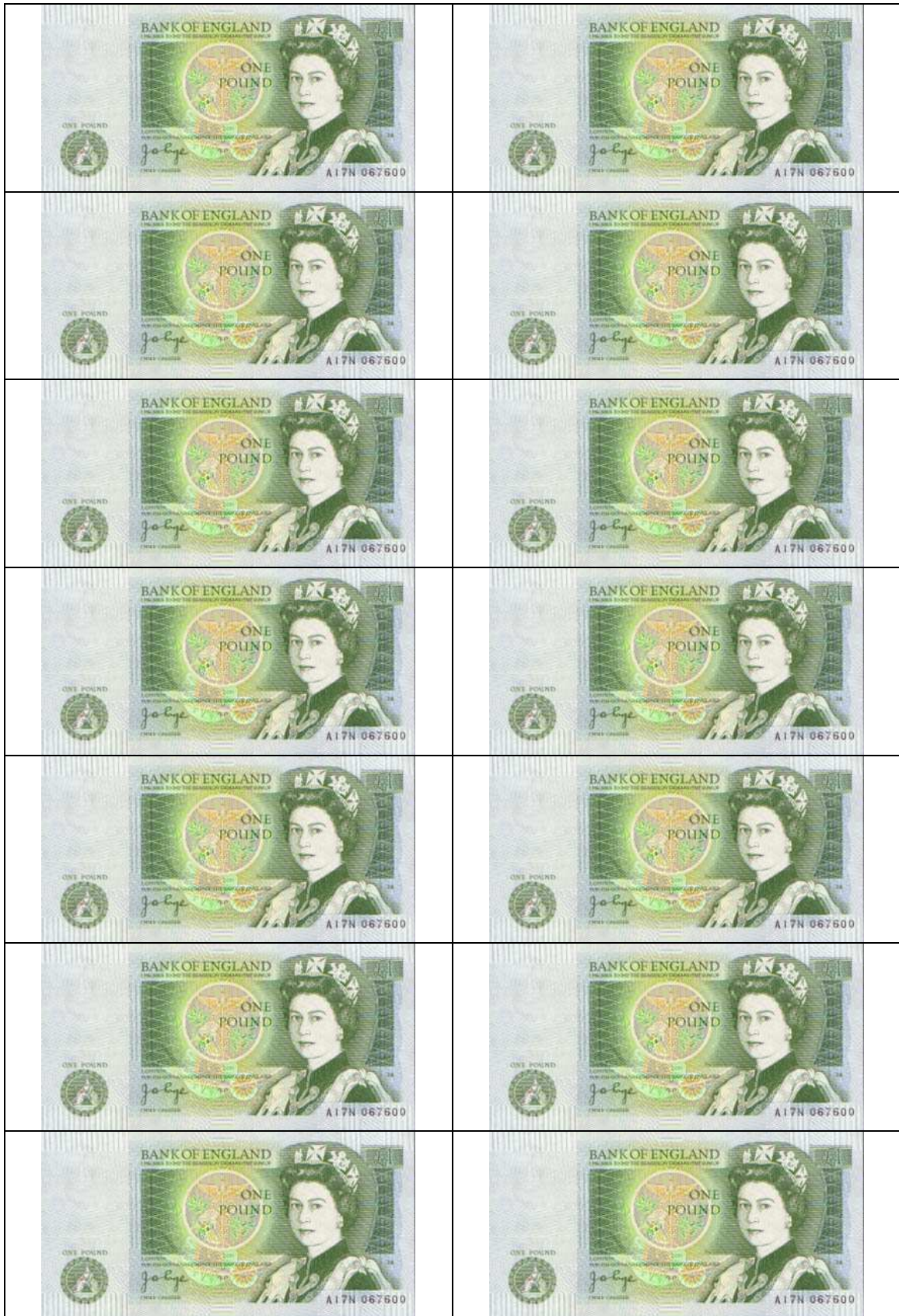
